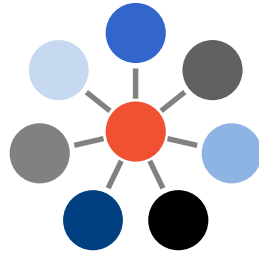


The Forgotten Known

Attachment Theory in Practice



About the workshop

This full-day workshop is designed to assist social workers, counsellors, child protection workers, psychologists and allied health workers to develop a better understanding of adults, families and children with traumatic histories and attachment disruptions, and to enhance their skills in working with these people.

The workshop will enable participants to:

- ✓ Refresh their knowledge of the concepts of Attachment Theory, trauma and the impact of these on relationships
- ✓ Enhance their understanding of the motivations behind behaviours of adults and children who have experienced trauma and attachment disruption
- ✓ Develop skills in working directly with clients who have experienced trauma and attachment disruption. These skills will be useful for both short-term and long-term interventions.

The workshop will be filled with practice-based practical examples. Interventions and concepts introduced in the workshop will be discussed and illustrated with the use of an informal interactive lecture, video clips and brief experiential exercises. Extensive notes will be provided.
