This two-day Paediatric ALS Program is suitable for health professionals in the provision of paediatric advanced life support in a clinical setting. Accredited by the Australian College of Critical Care Nurses (ACCCN) and based on the latest Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines, the program includes a comprehensive paediatric ALS manual, access to an e-learning quiz and a 2-day interactive workshop which includes assessment and certification.
