## Advanced Life Support Certification Program

### Target Audience

Registered nurses, medical officers and paramedical staff who:


- Require paediatric ALS certification
- Are new to emergency, intensive care, anaesthetics, recovery or HDU
- Work in small facilities with limited medical cover

### Course Overview

This two-day Paediatric ALS Program is suitable for health professionals in the provision of paediatric advanced life support in a clinical setting. Accredited by the Australian College of Critical Care Nurses (ACCCN) and based on the latest Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines, the program includes a comprehensive paediatric ALS manual, access to an e-learning quiz and a 2-day interactive workshop which includes assessment and certification.

- Pharmacology
- Legal and ethical
- Electrical therapy
- Post resuscitation care
- Advanced airway management
- Paediatric anatomy & physiology
- BLS & ALS algorithms and principles
